A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act prohibiting waiver of tuition and fees for employees of the University
2 of Alaska."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 14.40.170(b) is amended to read:

5 (b) The Board of Regents may

6 (1) adopt reasonable rules, orders, and plans with reasonable penalties
7 for the good government of the university and for the regulation of the Board of
8 Regents;

9 (2) determine and regulate the course of instruction in the university
10 with the advice of the president;

11 (3) set student tuition and fees; **the board may not waive or reduce**
12 **tuition or fees based on employment with the University of Alaska;**

13 (4) receive university receipts and, subject to legislative appropriation,
14 expend university receipts in accordance with AS 37.07 (Executive Budget Act). ["

1 * **Sec. 2.** APPLICABILITY. This Act applies to tuition or fees due on or after the
2 effective date of this Act.
