A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

**1 "An Act relating to peace officer powers of employees of the Alcoholic Beverage
2 Control Board; and providing for an effective date."**

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 * Section 1. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new
5 section to read:

6 FINDINGS AND INTENT. (a) The legislature finds that

**7 (1) proper enforcement of laws applicable to individuals who are licensed to
8 sell alcoholic beverages is critical to the health and safety of all Alaskans;**

**9 (2) Alcoholic Beverage Control Board enforcement powers must be carried out
10 by peace officers with appropriate investigative powers and training;**

**11 (3) the Alaska state troopers are capable of investigating and enforcing the
12 alcohol laws of the state.**

**13 (b) It is the intent of the legislature that the Department of Public Safety and
14 municipal police departments, not employees of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board,**

- 1 enforce statutes relating to alcohol.
- 2 * **Sec. 2.** AS 04.06.110 is repealed.
- 3 * **Sec. 3.** This Act takes effect July 1, 2000.
