A RESOLUTION

1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Alaska relating to
2 certain public corporations.

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 * Section 1. Article III, sec. 26, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is amended to read:

5 Section 26. Boards and Commissions. When a board or commission is at the
6 head of a principal department or a regulatory or quasi-judicial agency, or is the
7 governing entity of a public corporation established by law that manages significant
8 State assets as defined by law, its members shall be appointed by the governor, subject
9 to confirmation by a majority of the members of the legislature in joint session, and may
10 be removed as provided by law. They shall be citizens of the United States. The board
11 or commission may appoint a principal executive officer when authorized by law, but the
12 appointment shall be subject to the approval of the governor. With respect to public
13 corporations, the legislature may by law exclude the applicability of this section to
14 a public corporation.

15 * Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed before the voters of the
16 state at the next general election in conformity with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State

1 of Alaska, and the election laws of the state.
