A legislator or legislative employee may serve on a board of an
organization, including a governmental entity, that regularly has a substantial
interest in the legislative activities of the legislator or employee, if the
legislator or employee discloses the board membership to the committee. A
legislative employee may not serve in a position that requires confirmation
by the legislature.
