A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act determining the facilities constituting a school for purposes of public
2 school funding; and providing for an effective date."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 14.17.905 is amended to read:

5 **Sec. 14.17.905. Facilities constituting a school.** For purposes of this chapter,
6 the determination of the number of schools in a district is subject to the following:

7 (1) a community with an ADM of at least 10, but not more than 100,
8 shall be counted as one school;

9 (2) a community with an ADM of at least 101, but not more than **450**
10 [750], shall be counted as

11 (A) one elementary school, which includes those students in
12 grades kindergarten through **six** [6]; and

13 (B) one secondary school, which includes students in grades
14 **seven** [7] through 12;

1 (3) in a community with an ADM of greater than 450 [750], each
2 facility that is administered as a separate school shall be counted as one school, except
3 that each alternative school with an ADM of less than 200 shall be counted as a part
4 of the school in the district with the highest ADM.

5 * **Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect July 1, 1999.
