A RESOLUTION

1 Authorizing a recess by the Senate and the House of Representatives for a period
2 of more than three days.

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 WHEREAS art. II, sec. 10, Constitution of the State of Alaska, provides that neither
5 house may adjourn or recess for longer than three days unless the other house concurs; and

6 WHEREAS Rule 52, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, provides that
7 adoption of a concurrent resolution by a majority vote of the full membership of each house
8 constitutes concurrence;

9 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Senate and the House of
10 Representatives may be in recess during February 27 and 28 and during March 1 and 2 of
11 1999, and that each house concurs in this four-day recess by the other.
