3 * Section 1. AS 28.10.181(b) is amended to read:

4 (b) Historic vehicles. The owner of a [AN] historic vehicle may make
5 application for special registration under this subsection. The department, when
6 satisfied that the vehicle meets the requirements for historic vehicle registration under
7 regulations adopted by the commissioner, shall register the vehicle and (1) issue two
8 permanent registration plates of distinctive design and color bearing no date; vehicles
9 [THESE PLATES REMAIN WITH THE VEHICLE AS LONG AS IT IS
10 REGISTERED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION. VEHICLES] qualifying for
11 registration under this paragraph [SUBSECTION] shall be issued registration plates
12 numbered in a separate numerical series beginning with "Historic Vehicle No. 1"; or
13 (2) allow the vehicle to use registration plates of this state supplied by the vehicle
