8 (a) The commissioner or an authorized deputy shall issue each license and tag
9 to a qualified person under written application containing such reasonable information
10 as required by the commissioner. The commissioner shall designate the license and
11 tag form or type. The form or type must be sufficient to identify and locate the
12 applicant **and** [,] establish the applicant's status as to residency and citizenship [, AND
13 SUPPLY THE PERSON'S SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER IF REQUIRED BY
14 THIS CHAPTER]. Each application shall be subscribed [AND SWORN TO] by the
applicant [BEFORE AN OFFICER AUTHORIZED TO ADMINISTER OATHS IN
