**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act repealing a prohibition on the issuance of a restaurant or eating place license**  
2 **when the license applicant is a representative or owner of a certain type of business**  
3 **holding an alcoholic beverage license."**

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 \* **Section 1.** AS 04.11.450(b) is amended to read:

6 (b) A person who is a representative or owner of a wholesale business,  
7 brewery, winery, bottling works, or distillery may not be issued, solely or together  
8 with others, a beverage dispensary license [, A RESTAURANT OR EATING PLACE  
9 LICENSE,] or package store license. A holder of a beverage dispensary license may  
10 be issued a brewpub license, subject to the provisions of AS 04.11.135. [THE  
11 PROHIBITION AGAINST ISSUANCE OF A RESTAURANT OR EATING PLACE  
12 LICENSE IMPOSED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A  
13 RESTAURANT OR EATING PLACE LICENSE ISSUED ON OR BEFORE  
14 OCTOBER 1, 1996 OR A RESTAURANT OR EATING PLACE LICENSE ISSUED

1 UNDER AN APPLICATION FOR A RESTAURANT OR EATING PLACE  
2 LICENSE APPROVED ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 1996.]
