A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act extending the time for the Department of Administration to submit the terms of**
2 **a tentative collective bargaining agreement following a gubernatorial election year."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 23.40.215(b) is amended to read:

5 (b) The Department of Administration shall submit the monetary terms of an
6 agreement to the legislature within 10 legislative days after the agreement of the
7 parties, if the legislature is in session, or within 10 legislative days after the convening
8 of the next regular session. The complete monetary and nonmonetary terms of a
9 tentative agreement shall be submitted to the legislature no later than the 60th day of
10 the legislative session, or no later than the 90th day of the legislative session
11 immediately following a gubernatorial election, to receive legislative consideration
12 during that calendar year. However, if the department has submitted a tentative
13 agreement in a timely manner and the parties to the agreement decide to renegotiate
14 the terms, the renegotiated agreement shall be considered to have been submitted in a

1 timely manner. In this subsection, "tentative agreement" means an agreement that has
2 been reached by the negotiators for the employer and the bargaining unit but that may
3 not yet have been ratified by the members of the bargaining unit.
