FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to the constitutional right to privacy."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 *** Section 1.** AS 01.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

4 **Article 5. Implementation of the Right to Privacy.**

5 **Sec. 01.10.120. Implementation of the right to privacy.** (a) The right of the
6 people to privacy set out in art. I, sec. 22, Constitution of the State of Alaska, does not
7 create a right to receive public money, a public benefit, or a public service.

8 (b) This section is enacted as part of the legislature's obligation to implement
9 the constitutional right to privacy under art. I, sec. 22, Constitution of the State of
10 Alaska.

11 *** Sec. 2.** AS 18.80 is amended by adding a new section to read:

12 **Sec. 18.80.205. Application of constitutional right to privacy to AS 18.80.**

14 *** Sec. 3.** AS 47.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

15 **Sec. 47.05.110. Application of constitutional right to privacy to this title.**
