A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to certain motor vehicles that are required to yield to following**
2 **traffic."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 *** Section 1.** AS 28.35.140 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5 (b) A person operating a motor vehicle below the posted speed limit at any
6 time on a two-lane roadway shall pull the motor vehicle off the roadway at the first
7 opportunity to pull over safely whenever there is at least 100 feet of visible and
8 unobstructed roadway in front of that motor vehicle and there are five or more motor
9 vehicles immediately following that motor vehicle. A person operating a motor
10 vehicle who violates this subsection is guilty of an infraction as described in
11 AS 28.40.050(d) and shall be punished by a fine of at least \$200, and the department
12 shall assess two points against the person's driver's license.
