A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to an assistant adjutant general for space and missile defense in the**
2 **Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 26.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 **Sec. 26.05.185. Assistant adjutant general for space and missile defense.**

6 (a) The adjutant general, with the concurrence of the governor, may appoint an
7 assistant adjutant general for space and missile defense. The adjutant general for
8 space and missile defense is the official military representative of the state in matters
9 pertaining to the development and deployment of a missile defense program in this
10 state.

11 (b) The assistant adjutant general for space and missile defense shall be a
12 federally-recognized general grade officer in the Alaska National Guard or an officer
13 in the grade of colonel in the Alaska National Guard who has qualifications to gain
14 federal recognition as a general grade officer.

1 (c) The position of assistant adjutant general for space and missile defense is
2 authorized for the duration of the development and deployment of a missile defense
3 program in this state, subject to legislative appropriation of federal money available
4 for that purpose.

5 * **Sec. 2.** AS 39.25.110 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

6 (34) the assistant adjutant general for space and missile defense
7 appointed under AS 26.05.185.
