**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1    **"An Act relating to the delay of the reduction of supplementary public school funding;**  
2    **and providing for an effective date."**

3    **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4    \* **Section 1.** AS 14.17.490(d) is amended to read:

5           (d) Beginning in fiscal year **2004** [2000], if a district receives more public  
6           school funding under AS 14.17.410 than the district received in the preceding fiscal  
7           year, any amount received by the district under this section shall be reduced. The  
8           amount of the reduction required under this subsection is equal to the amount of  
9           increase from the preceding fiscal year in public school funding multiplied by 40  
10          percent. In this subsection, "public school funding" does not include funding under  
11          this section.

12    \* **Sec. 2.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to  
13    read:

14          **APPLICABILITY.** This Act does not affect any reductions under AS 14.17.490(d) for

1 fiscal years 2000 and 2001.

2 \* **Sec. 3.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to  
3 read:

4       TRANSITION: REGULATIONS. Notwithstanding sec. 5 of this Act, the state Board  
5 of Education and Early Development may immediately proceed to adopt regulations  
6 necessary to implement the changes made by this Act. The regulations take effect under  
7 AS 44.62 (Administrative Procedure Act), but not before the effective date of the statutory  
8 change.

9 \* **Sec. 4.** Section 3 of this Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).

10 \* **Sec. 5.** Sections 1 and 2 of this Act take effect July 1, 2001.
