A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act requiring nonresident hunters to be accompanied when hunting moose; and**
2 **providing for an effective date."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 *** Section 1.** AS 16.05.407(a) is amended to read:

5 (a) It is unlawful for a nonresident to hunt, pursue, or take brown bear, grizzly
6 bear, mountain goat, moose, or sheep in this state [,] unless personally accompanied
7 by

8 (1) a person who is licensed as a registered guide, master guide, class-
9 A assistant guide, or an assistant guide under AS 08.54; or

10 (2) a resident over 19 years of age who is

11 (A) the spouse of the nonresident; or

12 (B) related to the nonresident, within and including the second
13 degree of kindred, by marriage or blood.

14 *** Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect January 1, 2002.
