A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act instructing the State Board of Registration for Architects, Engineers, and Land**
2 **Surveyors to adopt minimum technical standards relating to the practice of surveying."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 08.48 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 **Sec. 08.48.267. Minimum technical standards for surveying.** The board
6 shall adopt regulations relating to the practice of surveying that establish minimum
7 technical standards to ensure the achievement of no less than minimum degrees of
8 accuracy, completeness, and quality in order to assure adequate and defensible real
9 property boundary locations and other pertinent information provided by surveyors
10 under the authority of AS 08.48.171 - 08.48.295.
