A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act making an appropriation for support of kindergarten, primary, and secondary**
2 **education programs and for the community schools program for fiscal year 2003; and**
3 **providing for an effective date."**

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 * **Section 1.** (a) The sum of \$765,174,400 is appropriated from the general fund to the
6 forward funding account (AS 14.07.065) for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003, for the
7 following purposes: state aid to public schools program, child nutrition program, tuition
8 students program, boarding home grants program, youth in detention program, pupil
9 transportation program, schools for the handicapped program, community schools program,
10 state boarding schools program, and state centralized correspondence study program.

11 (b) Unless expressly stated otherwise in the Act making the appropriation, the amount
12 appropriated by (a) of this section is reduced by an amount equal to that appropriated to the
13 Department of Education and Early Development for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003,
14 from any of the following fund sources for any of the following purposes:

1 (1) fund sources: general fund/mental health, public school trust fund
2 (AS 37.14.110), school fund (AS 43.50.140), and federal receipts;

3 (2) purposes: state aid to public schools program, child nutrition program,
4 tuition students program, boarding home grants program, youth in detention program, pupil
5 transportation program, schools for the handicapped program, community schools program,
6 state boarding school program, and state centralized correspondence study program.

7 * **Sec. 2.** The appropriation made by this Act is contingent upon the passage by the
8 legislature and the enactment into law before January 1, 2002, of a bill establishing the
9 forward funding account.

10 * **Sec. 3.** This Act takes effect July 1, 2001.
