A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to financing facilities for municipal ports and harbors; and providing**
2 **for an effective date."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska enacted in sec. 10(e), ch. 130, SLA
5 2000, is amended to read:
