**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act relating to wage and hour protections for employees of the Alaska Railroad**  
2 **Corporation."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 \* **Section 1.** AS 42.40.710 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5 (b) Except as provided in this subsection, employees of the corporation are  
6 covered by AS 23.10.050 - 23.10.150 (Alaska Wage and Hour Act). If the terms of a  
7 collective bargaining agreement that was mutually agreed upon by an organization  
8 representing train or engine service employees and the corporation so provide,  
9 AS 23.10.050 - 23.10.150 do not apply to train or engine service employees to the  
10 extent set out in the collective bargaining agreement.

11 \* **Sec. 2.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to  
12 read:

13 **APPLICABILITY.** (a) This Act applies to work performed on or after the effective  
14 date of this Act.

1           (b) This Act does not terminate or modify the terms of a collective bargaining  
2 agreement in effect on the effective date of this Act.
