FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to the constitutional right to privacy."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 *** Section 1.** AS 18.80 is amended by adding a new section to read:

4 **Sec. 18.80.205. Application of constitutional right to privacy to benefits**
5 **for unmarried partners.** (a) The right of the people to privacy set out in art. I, sec.
6 22, Constitution of the State of Alaska, does not extend to a right to receive state
7 benefits based on a person's domestic partnership with another person that is not a
8 legal marriage to the other person.

9 (b) This section is enacted as part of the legislature's obligation to implement
10 the constitutional right to privacy under art. I, sec. 22, Constitution of the State of
11 Alaska.

12 *** Sec. 2.** AS 47.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

13 **Sec. 47.05.110. Application of constitutional right to privacy to state**
14 **funding for abortions.** (a) The right of the people to privacy set out in art. I, sec. 22,
15 Constitution of the State of Alaska, does not extend to a right to receive state funding

1 for abortion.
