A BILL**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 "An Act making an appropriation to the University of Alaska Anchorage, School of
 2 Engineering, for a study of road design problems associated with studded tires and for
 3 recommendations regarding timing of construction contract awards; and providing for
 4 an effective date."

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

6 * **Section 1.** The sum of \$50,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the University of
 7 Alaska Anchorage, School of Engineering, for

8 (1) a study of, and a comprehensive report with recommendations on, road
 9 structure design problems associated with the use of studded tires and with road construction
 10 materials, specifically base course, paving, and drainage; and

11 (2) recommendations regarding the timing of construction contract awards in
 12 order to best complement sound construction practices.

13 * **Sec. 2.** The appropriation made by this Act is for a capital project and lapses under

1 AS 37.25.020.

2 * **Sec. 3.** This Act takes effect July 1, 2001.
