A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to certain motor vehicles that are required to yield to following traffic**
2 **and to fines for offenses committed in highway work zones."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 *** Section 1.** AS 28.35.140 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5 (b) A person operating a motor vehicle on a two-lane roadway outside of an
6 urban area shall pull the motor vehicle off the roadway at the first opportunity to pull
7 over safely whenever there are five or more motor vehicles immediately following that
8 motor vehicle. A person operating a motor vehicle who violates this subsection is
9 guilty of an infraction as described in AS 28.40.050(d) and shall be punished by a fine
10 of at least \$100.

11 *** Sec. 2.** AS 28.40.070 is amended to read:

12 **Sec. 28.40.070. Fines for offenses committed within highway work zones**
13 **doubled.** Whenever a person violates a provision of this title or a regulation adopted
14 under the authority of this title **and the violation occurs** within a highway work zone

1 **that has workers present at the time of the violation**, notwithstanding the amount of
2 the fine or the maximum fine set under this title, the fine, or maximum fine, is double
3 the amount provided in this title.
