FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act extending the termination date of the Regulatory Commission of Alaska to
2 June 30, 2004, and requiring the commission to perform a study on deregulation; and
3 providing for an effective date."

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 * **Section 1.** AS 44.66.010(a)(4) is amended to read:

6 (4) Regulatory Commission of Alaska (AS 42.04.010) -- June 30, 2004
7 [2002];

8 * **Sec. 2.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
9 read:

10 STUDY ON DEREGULATION OF PUBLIC UTILITIES. The Regulatory
11 Commission of Alaska shall immediately perform a comprehensive study of the utilities
12 subject to its regulatory authority in order to recommend which utilities should be
13 deregulated. The results of the study shall be presented to the legislature in a written report
14 not later than January 21, 2003.

1 * **Sec. 3.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
