This bill will allow pipeline right-of-way renewals for up to 30 years rather than up to 10 years. This change may result in savings to industry, who reimburses the state for expenses associated with renewal.

The bill will place in statute reimbursement for state oversight of pipelines under the jurisdiction of the ROWLA. At present, reimbursement is obtained on a case-by-case basis through agreements and contracts which are negotiated annually.

The proposed changes in AS 38.35.230(9) would eliminate the possibility of expensive and time consuming conflicts between land owners and managers regarding the need for pipeline rights-of-way over certain lands.
