Senate Bill 317 provides the Department with the authority to adopt regulations necessary to implement the revised federal forest receipts program. The federal program was revised with the passage of the "Secure Rural Schools and Self-Determination Act of 2000" (P.L. 106-393).

It also corrects a statutory problem created by the merger of the former Department of Community and Economic Development and former Department of Community and Regional Affairs by providing the Department with general regulation adoption authority to carry out its statutory functions.
