A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to the hours during which sale of alcohol and entry on licensed**
2 **premises is allowed; and providing for an effective date."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 *** Section 1.** AS 04.16.010(a) is amended to read:

5 (a) A person may not sell, offer for sale, give, furnish, deliver, or consume an
6 alcoholic beverage on premises licensed under this title between the hours of **2:00**
7 **[5:00]** a.m. and 8:00 a.m. each day.

8 *** Sec. 2.** AS 04.16.010(b) is amended to read:

9 (b) A licensee, an agent, or **an** employee may not permit a person to consume
10 alcoholic beverages on the licensed premises between the hours of **2:00** **[5:00]** a.m.
11 and 8:00 a.m. each day.

12 *** Sec. 3.** AS 04.16.010(c) is amended to read:

13 (c) A licensee, an agent, or **an** employee may not permit a person to enter and
14 a person may not enter premises licensed under this title between the hours of **2:00**

1 [5:00] a.m. and 8:00 a.m. each day. This subsection does not apply to common
2 carriers or to an employee of the licensee who is on the premises to prepare for the
3 next day's business. A person may enter or remain on the premises of a bona fide
4 restaurant or eating place licensed under this title to consume food or nonalcoholic
5 beverages.

6 * **Sec. 4.** This Act takes effect July 1, 2001.
