Dear Ms. Barnett:

I have previously disclosed that I am a shareholder of Cook Inlet Region, Inc. As a shareholder I own an undivideable interest in the subsurface lands owned by CIRC and the surface lands held by Kenai Native Association which has a profit sharing formula with CIRC. My shares in CIRC are not saleable or transferable under ANCSA. My wife owns a real estate company that I am an agent of that does real estate for Kenai Native Association, which was disclosed on the 2000 and 2001 Legislative Financial Disclosure Statements. None of the real estate activities that we are involved with in any manner are connected with the proposed joint venture to build a prison in Kenai. There has been a legislative bill introduced to build a prison in Kenai, sponsored by Representative Mike Chenault. If the proposed legislation should pass it may benefit Kenai Native Association and CIRC. The legislation does not impact my wife or me financially, personally, or in any other beneficial manner other than as an ANCSA shareholder.

I am again disclosing this information in an effort to comply with the ethics requirements.
