A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act extending the termination date of the State Board of Registration for**
2 **Architects, Engineers, and Land Surveyors to June 30, 2005; relating to the temporary**
3 **member of that board; and providing for an effective date."**

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 * **Section 1.** AS 08.03.010(c)(3) is amended to read:

6 (3) State Board of Registration for Architects, Engineers, and Land
7 Surveyors (AS 08.48.011) -- June 30, 2005 [2001];

8 * **Sec. 2.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska enacted in sec. 31, ch. 47, SLA 1998, is
9 amended to read:

10 Sec. 31. TEMPORARY BOARD MEMBER. After considering
11 recommendations made by the Alaska chapter of the American Society of Landscape
12 Architects, the governor shall appoint a landscape architect to the Board of
13 Registration for Architects, Engineers, and Land Surveyors. The person appointed
14 under this section

1 (1) must have been a resident in the state for three consecutive years
2 immediately preceding appointment;

3 (2) serves in an advisory, nonvoting capacity on the board;

4 (3) is [NOT] entitled to receive state money for per diem or travel
5 expenses for work as a board member;

6 (4) serves a term that expires June 30, 2005 [2001]; and must be
7 registered as a landscape architect under AS 08.48 [BY THE DATE DETERMINED
8 UNDER SEC. 30 OF THIS ACT].

9 * **Sec. 3.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
10 read:

11 TRANSITION: TEMPORARY BOARD MEMBER. The term of the temporary
12 board member of the State Board of Registration for Architects, Engineers, and Land
13 Surveyors (AS 08.48.011) expires on June 30, 2001. The temporary board member serving
14 on June 30, 2001 is eligible for reappointment under sec. 2 of this Act so long as the member
15 continues to meet the qualifications set out in sec. 2 of this Act. The temporary member may
16 remain in the position until the governor names a new appointee or reappoints the temporary
17 member.

18 * **Sec. 4.** This Act takes effect July 1, 2001.
