5 \* **Section 1.** AS 03.58.010 is repealed and reenacted to read:

6           **Sec. 03.58.010. Prohibition.** A person may not sell, offer for sale, represent,  
7 or label a raw or processed agricultural product, including ingredients, as "organic"  
8 unless the product has been produced, handled, and certified under 7 U.S.C. 6501 -  
9 6522, as amended, or under the state organic certification program established under  
10 AS 03.58.015.

11 \* **Sec. 2.** AS 03.58 is amended by adding a new section to read:

12           **Sec. 03.58.015. State organic certification program.** (a) The department  
13 may establish a state organic certification program for producers and handlers of  
14 agricultural products within the state that meets the requirements for approval under 7

2 (b) The department may apply under 7 U.S.C. 6514, as amended, for  
3 accreditation as a certifying agent under 7 U.S.C. 6501 - 6522, as amended.
