A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act allowing an employee's wage to be reduced below the minimum wage to**
2 **provide adequate health care."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 *** Section 1.** AS 23.10.065 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5 (d) An employer, with the agreement of the employee, may pay up to \$2 less
6 than the hourly wage required under (a) of this section if the amount of the reduction
7 is used by the employer to provide adequate health care as defined by the
8 commissioner.
