**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act relating to harassment."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 \* **Section 1.** AS 11.61.120(a) is amended to read:

4 (a) A person commits the crime of harassment if, with intent to harass or  
5 annoy another person, that person

6 (1) insults, taunts, or challenges another person in a manner likely to  
7 provoke an immediate violent response;

8 (2) telephones another and fails to terminate the connection with intent  
9 to impair the ability of that person to place or receive telephone calls;

10 (3) makes repeated telephone calls at extremely inconvenient hours;

11 (4) makes an anonymous or obscene telephone call **or electronic**  
12 **communication** or a telephone call **or electronic communication** that threatens  
13 physical injury; or

14 (5) subjects another person to offensive physical contact.
