**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act relating to tuition at the University of Alaska."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 \* **Section 1.** AS 14.40.170(b) is amended to read:

4 (b) The Board of Regents may

5 (1) adopt reasonable rules, orders, and plans with reasonable penalties  
6 for the good government of the university and for the regulation of the Board of  
7 Regents;

8 (2) determine and regulate the course of instruction in the university  
9 with the advice of the president;

10 (3) set student tuition and fees; **the board shall require that a**  
11 **student, in order to qualify as a state resident for purposes of tuition, be a**  
12 **resident of the state for at least one year and a United States citizen or a legal**  
13 **alien;**

14 (4) receive university receipts and, subject to legislative appropriation,  
15 expend university receipts in accordance with AS 37.07 (Executive Budget Act).
