A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act prohibiting sales of certain soft drinks in public schools."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** AS 14.03 is amended by adding a new section to read:

4 **Sec. 14.03.135. Sale of certain soft drinks prohibited.** (a) Between the
5 hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. during a day in session at a public school as
6 described under AS 14.03.040, carbonated soft drinks and soft drinks that contain 42
7 or more grams of sugar per 20-ounce serving may not be sold in a public school
8 building or on public school property.

9 (b) This section does not apply to soft drinks that contain at least 50 percent
10 fruit juice.
