A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to public school education programs on the abuse of alcohol and**
2 **drugs."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 *** Section 1.** AS 14.30.360(a) is amended to read:

5 (a) Each district in the state public school system shall be encouraged to
6 initiate and conduct a program in health education for kindergarten through grade 12.
7 The program should include instruction in physical health and personal safety
8 including [ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE EDUCATION,] cardiopulmonary
9 resuscitation (CPR), early cancer prevention and detection, dental health, family health
10 including infant care, environmental health, the identification and prevention of child
11 abuse, child abduction, neglect, sexual abuse, and domestic violence, and appropriate
12 use of health services.

13 *** Sec. 2.** AS 14.30.360 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

14 (c) Each district in the state public school system shall conduct an age-

1 appropriate program in alcohol and drug abuse education for kindergarten through
2 grade 12. The program must include the legal, health, and social consequences of
3 alcohol and drug abuse.
