A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to concealed handguns; allowing persons whose applications have been**
2 **rejected as unqualified or whose permits have been revoked or suspended to continue to**
3 **carry concealed handguns in this state if the person has a permit from another**
4 **jurisdiction; requiring the Department of Public Safety to enter into reciprocity**
5 **agreements concerning the carrying of concealed handguns."**

6 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

7 *** Section 1.** AS 18.65.748 is amended to read:

8 **Sec. 18.65.748. Permit holders from other jurisdictions considered Alaska**
9 **permit holders.** A person holding a valid permit to carry a concealed handgun from
10 another state or a political subdivision of another state is a permittee under
11 AS 18.65.700(b) for purposes of AS 18.65.750 - 18.65.765 [IF THE PERSON HAS
12 NOT HAD AN APPLICATION FOR A CONCEALED HANDGUN PERMIT
13 REJECTED IN THIS STATE BECAUSE THE PERSON WAS UNQUALIFIED

1 UNDER AS 18.65.705 OR HAD A CONCEALED HANDGUN PERMIT
2 REVOKED OR SUSPENDED BY THIS STATE].

3 * **Sec. 2.** AS 18.65.775 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

4 (b) The department shall enter into reciprocity agreements with other states so
5 that permittees may carry concealed handguns in those other states.
