A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to jury duty; and amending Rule 15(k), Alaska Rules of**
2 **Administration."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 *** Section 1.** AS 09.20.030 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5 (b) A person may claim exemption and may be excused from service as a juror
6 if it is shown that the person is a teacher in a school that has failed to make adequate
7 yearly progress under P.L. 107-110. In this subsection, "teacher" has the meaning
8 given in AS 14.03.290.

9 *** Sec. 2.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
10 read:

11 **INDIRECT COURT RULE AMENDMENT.** AS 09.20.030(b), added by sec. 1 of
12 this Act, has the effect of amending Rule 15(k), Alaska Rules of Administration, by
13 establishing an additional cause for exemption from jury service.
