**A RESOLUTION**

1 **Proposing an amendment to the Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature relating**  
2 **to executive sessions of legislative bodies; and providing for an effective date for the**  
3 **amendment.**

4 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 \* **Section 1.** Rule 22(b), Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, is amended to read:

6 (b) A legislative body may call an executive session at which members of the  
7 general public may be excluded for the following reasons:

8 (1) discussion of matters, the immediate knowledge of which would  
9 adversely affect the finances of a government unit;

10 (2) discussion of subjects that tend to prejudice the reputation and  
11 character of a person;

12 (3) discussion of a matter that may, by law, be required to be  
13 confidential;

14 **(4) discussion of a matter that affects the security of the state or**  
15 **nation, or that affects the security of a governmental unit or agency.**
