**A RESOLUTION**

1 **Establishing a House Special Committee on Military and Veterans' Affairs.**

2 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:**

3 **WHEREAS** a large number of state residents currently serve in the military forces,  
4 work for the military, or are veterans, and the military plays a vital role in the economy of the  
5 state; and

6 **WHEREAS** there is a need for a comprehensive review of issues involving military  
7 and veterans' affairs;

8 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the House of Representatives that the House Special  
9 Committee on Military and Veterans' Affairs is established to study issues, review laws, and  
10 propose legislation relating to military and veterans' affairs; and be it

11 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the speaker of the House of Representatives shall  
12 determine the number of representatives to be members of the committee and shall appoint  
13 the members and designate a member to chair the committee; and be it

14 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the House Special Committee on Military and  
15 Veterans' Affairs may meet during and between sessions of the Twenty-Third Alaska State  
16 Legislature and is terminated on the convening of the First Session of the Twenty-Fourth

1 Alaska State Legislature.
