A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act extending the renewal period for oil discharge prevention and contingency
2 plans; and providing for an effective date."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 46.04.030(d) is amended to read:

5 (d) Upon approval of a contingency plan, the department shall issue to the
6 plan holder a certificate stating that the contingency plan has been approved by the
7 department. The certificate must include the name of the facility, pipeline, tank
8 vessel, or oil barge for which it is issued, the effective date of the contingency plan,
9 and the date by which the contingency plan must be submitted for renewal. A
10 contingency plan must be submitted for renewal every five [THREE] years.

11 * **Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
