FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to the crime of distribution of child pornography."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** AS 11.61.125(d) is amended to read:

4 (d) In this section, "distribution" includes **the following, whether or not for**
5 **monetary or other consideration:** delivering, selling, renting, leasing, lending,
6 giving, circulating, exhibiting, presenting, providing, exchanging, [AND] placing on a
7 computer network or computer system, **and providing billing collection, or other**
8 **ancillary services for or otherwise supporting these activities** [WHETHER OR
9 NOT FOR MONETARY OR OTHER CONSIDERATION].

10 * **Sec. 2.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
11 read:

12 APPLICABILITY. The changes to the definition of distribution made in sec. 1 of this
13 Act apply to offenses occurring on or after the effective date of this Act.
