A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to terms and duties of the members of the State Board of Registration**
2 **for Architects, Engineers and Land Surveyors."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 *** Section 1.** AS 08.48.021 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5 (c) For purposes of determining appointments and terms under AS 08.01.035,
6 notwithstanding the reference in that section relating to eligibility for reappointment
7 after serving a full or partial term,

8 (1) a member who has served all of two successive terms on the board
9 may not be reappointed to the board unless four years have elapsed since the person
10 has last served on the board; and

11 (2) for purposes of (1) of this subsection, a person who serves for two
12 years or more of a four-year term is considered to have served a full term.

13 *** Sec. 2.** AS 08.48.101(a) is amended to read:

14 (a) The board may adopt regulations to carry out the purpose of this chapter,

1 including **regulations**

2 (1) describing the contents of an examination;

3 (2) establishing the conduct of an examination;

4 (3) establishing a minimum score for passing an examination;

5 (4) establishing bylaws governing its meetings and activities;

6 (5) publishing a code of ethics or professional conduct for those
7 persons regulated by this chapter, including corporations, limited liability companies,
8 and limited liability partnerships under AS 08.48.241;

9 **(6) establishing continuing education requirements for persons**
10 **regulated by this chapter that must be completed before a certificate may be**
11 **renewed.**
