**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 "An Act prohibiting certain shipments of alcoholic beverages and requiring a  
2 determination of residency before shipping alcoholic beverages."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 \* **Section 1.** AS 04.11.150(h) is amended to read:

5 (h) A package store licensee, agent, or employee may not

6 **(1) divide or combine shipments of alcoholic beverages so as to**  
7 **circumvent the limitation imposed under (g) of this section; or**

8 **(2) ship alcoholic beverages to a purchaser who resides in an area**  
9 **that has prohibited the importation or possession of alcoholic beverages under**  
10 **AS 04.11.491(a)(4) or (5), or (b)(3) or (4); before shipping alcoholic beverages, the**  
11 **licensee, agent, or employee shall determine the residency of the purchaser; for**  
12 **purposes of this paragraph, "residency" means a person's principal place of**  
13 **abode at which the person intends to remain indefinitely and to make a home.**
