**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act relating to an optional election to prevent the name and address of a permanent**  
2 **fund dividend applicant from being disclosed, except to a state or federal agency."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 **\* Section 1.** AS 43.23 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 **Sec. 43.23.017. Election to keep name confidential.** The department shall  
6 include on each permanent fund dividend application form the option for an applicant  
7 to elect to keep the applicant's name and address confidential. An individual who files  
8 a dividend application on behalf of another may elect to keep the filer's name and  
9 address and the name and address of the individual on whose behalf the application is  
10 filed confidential. Notwithstanding other provisions, if a confidentiality election is  
11 made under this section, the department may only release the name and address

- 12 (1) to a state or federal agency;  
13 (2) in compliance with a court order; or  
14 (3) as directed by the individual who made the confidentiality election.

1     \* **Sec. 2.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to  
2 read:

3             APPLICATION. AS 43.23.017, added in sec. 1 of this Act, applies to applications for  
4 the 2005 permanent fund dividend and for dividends for years thereafter.
