**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act amending the definition of 'lobbyist' in the Regulation of Lobbying Act; and**  
2 **providing for an effective date."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 **\* Section 1.** AS 24.45.171(8) is amended to read:

5 (8) "lobbyist" means a person who

6 (A) engages in the business, occupation, or profession of  
7 influencing legislative or administrative action; or

8 (B) receives wages or other economic consideration, including  
9 reimbursement of travel and living expenses, to communicate directly with any  
10 public official

11 (i) for the express purpose of influencing legislative or  
12 administrative action; and

13 (ii) during more than **20** [40] hours in any 30-day  
14 period in one calendar year;

1      \* **Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect July 1, 2004.
