**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act relating to residency and internship permits issued by the State Medical Board;**  
2 **and providing for an effective date."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 **\* Section 1.** AS 08.64.272(c) is amended to read:

5 (c) A permit issued under this section is valid for the period specified by the  
6 board, but not to exceed 36 [18] months after the date of issue. Upon application by a  
7 person who pays the required fee and has been accepted by an eligible institution in  
8 the state for the purpose of residency or internship, the board may renew a permit  
9 issued under this section for a period specified by the board, but not to exceed 36 [18]  
10 months after the date of renewal.

11 **\* Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
