TWENTY-THIRD LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

**A RESOLUTION**

1 **Relating to requesting the Governor to negotiate a 40-hour workweek with state**  
2 **employees.**

3 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 **WHEREAS** a 40-hour workweek is a standard workweek throughout most industries  
5 in Alaska and the rest of the United States; and

6 **WHEREAS** a 40-hour workweek would result in a seven percent increase in state  
7 employee productivity; and

8 **WHEREAS** a 40-hour work week would increase public confidence in the efficiency  
9 and productivity of state employees; and

10 **WHEREAS** other industries are looking at similar measures to increase productivity  
11 and efficiency;

12 **BE IT RESOLVED** that the Alaska State Legislature requests the Governor to  
13 negotiate a 40-hour workweek with state employees; and be it

14 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Governor implement this standard workweek at no  
15 increased cost to the general fund.
