EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 109

1 Under the authority of art. III, sec. 23, of the Alaska Constitution, I order the
 2 following:

3 * **Section 1.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section
 4 to read:

5 FINDINGS. As governor, I find that the transfer of the Violent Crimes Compensation
 6 Board from the Department of Public Safety to the Department of Administration would be in
 7 the best interests of efficient administration. The support available in the Department of
 8 Administration for the board will facilitate the delivery of financial help to crime victims.

9 * **Sec. 2.** AS 18.67.020(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) There is the Violent Crimes Compensation Board in the Department of
 11 Administration [PUBLIC SAFETY] composed of three members to be appointed by
 12 the governor. One of the members shall be designated as chairman by the governor.
 13 At least one member must be a medical or osteopathic physician licensed to practice in
 14 this state and one member must be an attorney licensed to practice in this state.

15 * **Sec. 3.** AS 44.21.020 is amended to read:

16 **Sec. 44.21.020. Duties of department.** The Department of Administration
 17 shall

18 (1) make surveys and studies to improve administrative procedures,
 19 methods, and organization;

20 (2) keep general accounts;

21 (3) approve vouchers and disburse funds for all purposes;

22 (4) operate centralized purchasing and supply services, and necessary
 23 storerooms and warehouses;

1 (5) allot space in state buildings to the various departments according
2 to need and available space;

3 (6) supervise telephone, mailing, messenger, duplicating, and similar
4 services adaptable to centralized management;

5 (7) administer the public employees' retirement system and teachers'
6 retirement system;

7 (8) administer a statewide personnel program, including central
8 personnel services such as recruitment, assessment, position classification, and pay
9 administration;

10 (9) administer the Alaska Pioneers' Homes;

11 (10) administer and supervise a statewide automatic data processing
12 program;

13 (11) study, design, implement, and manage the telecommunications
14 systems and services of the state under AS 44.21.305 - 44.21.330;

15 (12) administer state veterans' home facilities; in carrying out its duties
16 under this paragraph, the department shall consult with the Department of Military and
17 Veterans' Affairs;

18 **(13) provide administrative services to the Violent Crimes**
19 **Compensation Board.**

20 * **Sec. 4** This Order takes effect July 1, 2003.
