Under this bill, if a person wins an award of damages, costs, or attorney fees under state laws that prohibit unfair trade practices, monopolies, and restraints of trade against a seafood processor, the court must require 15 percent of the award or \$40,000,000, whichever is less, be deposited in the state general fund.

Passage of this legislation is not anticipated to have a fiscal impact on the Department of Law.
