**ANALYSIS:** (Attach a separate page if necessary)

SCS CSHB 251 (TRA) exempts foreign pleasure craft of 65 feet or less in overall length from the mandatory pilotage requirement. New funds are not required to implement this bill.

However, the bill is anticipated to generate new revenue as a result of civil fines imposed and the application fee for waiver from the pilotage requirement. Based on the fee proposed in the bill and estimates from the industry, the revenue is based on: **1)** 6 pleasure crafts at 66' = 6 x \$300 = \$1,800; **2)** 12 pleasure crafts at 120' = 12 x \$3,000 = \$36,000; **3)** 6 pleasure crafts at 160' = 6 x \$5,000 = \$30,000. The revenue estimate is repeated in subsequent years however, the actual revenue will be based on the number of foreign registered pleasure crafts entering State waters.
