6 **\* Section 1.** AS 29.10.200 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

7 (64) AS 29.45.820 (severance tax on minerals).

8 **\* Sec. 2.** AS 29.45 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 **Sec. 29.45.820. Taxes on minerals.** A municipality may not impose a  
10 severance tax on minerals produced or extracted in the municipality other than a tax  
11 imposed before January 1, 2005. If a severance tax on minerals produced or extracted  
12 in a municipality was imposed before January 1, 2005, the municipality or its  
13 successor may continue to levy the tax, regardless of any subsequent annexation,  
14 merger, consolidation, unification, or reclassification of the municipality that imposed  
15 the tax before January 1, 2005. This section applies to home rule and general law  
16 municipalities. For purposes of this section, "mineral" means ore and mineral  
17 products other than sand, gravel, and coal."

\* **Sec. 12.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to read:

RETROACTIVITY. Sections 1 and 2 of this Act are retroactive to January 1, 2005.

\* **Sec. 13.** Section 11 of this Act takes effect September 1, 2006.

\* **Sec. 14.** Except as provided in sec. 13 of this Act, this Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c)."
